## Jog-a-thon

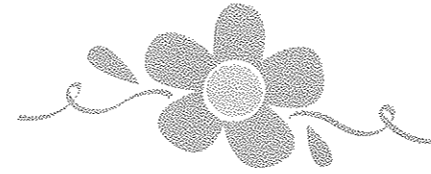
During a Jog-A-Thon, students jog as many laps as they can in their time frame. The goal for each student is to earn as much money as possible from as many sponsors as possible. A sponsor can pledge money based either upon number of laps completed by the student or by a fixed dollar amount. Look for pledge sheets to be sent home. On your students jog-a-thon day please be sure to make sure your student wears appropriate sunscreen and brings a water bottle.

## Spring Time Reminders

- Dress Code: Wear clothes that sufficiently conceal undergarments at all times. See through or fishnet fabrics, halter tops, off the shoulder tops, low cut tops, spaghetti straps, short crop tops, tube tops, tank tops, and shorts/skirts shorter than finger tips are prohibited. Flip-flops and open toe shoes are not acceptable. Students must wear appropriate shoes for P.E.
- School Rules: Students are to keep hands and all body parts to themselves. Pushing, shoving, lifting, carrying, swinging, or hitting students is absolutely unacceptable. Throwing or kicking balls at others is not permitted. Hard balls are not allowed at school.
- Drop off/Pick Up: Sequoia Families, please remember to follow all traffic and parking laws when dropping your students off in the morning and picking your students up in the afternoon. If using the parking lot circle, please do not park in the red fire lane. If using the gates at the front of the school; please park your car, use the crosswalk, and wait patiently. Please never double park your car. If your student rides a bike/scooter to school, by state law they **must wear a helmet**. Thank you for help to ensure the safety of all of our students!
